The Role:

The work will be performed under the direction of the Executive Director and also in liaison with the Board, the Methodology Committee and other working groups in accordance with the rules and procedures of GCD.

- Prepare presentations for both internal and external use
- Support some working groups by organizing and leading meetings, taking minutes and carrying out occasional analyses, surveys and extractions
- Keep close contact with selected members as part of a member
